### Investment objective

The Fund aims to provide capital growth and income by investing in a portfolio of investment grade bonds and similar securities denominated in US dollars (USD), while promoting environmental, social and governance (ESG) characteristics within the meaning of Article 8 of SFDR. The Fund aims to have a higher ESG score than its reference benchmark.

### Investment strategy

The Fund is actively managed.

The Fund will invest primarily in bonds (and other similar securities) issued in developed markets. Fund may invest in developed markets sovereigns, developed markets investment grade corporate securities, developed markets high yield corporate securities and emerging markets securities.

The Fund includes the identification and analysis of a company's ESG credentials as an integral part of the investment decision making process. Companies and/or issuers considered for inclusion within the Fund's portfolio will be subject to excluded activities in accordance with HSBC Asset Management's Responsible Investment Policies, which may change from time to time.

The Fund may invest up to 50% in asset-backed securities and mortgage-backed securities, up to 10% in contingent convertible securities, up to 10% in other funds, and in bank deposits and money market instruments

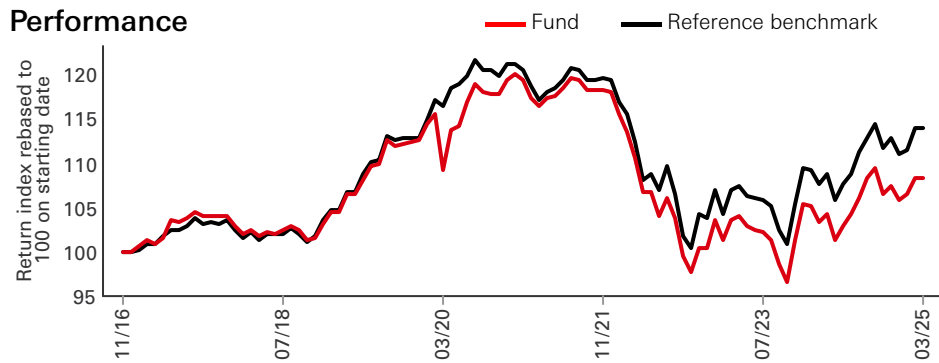

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## Benchmark disclosure
